

Mission Statement:

"The aim of Hampden House PRU is to provide a caring supportive environment which will allow the boys to successfully reintegrate into mainstream schools and their local community."

Statement of Purpose:

The principal aim of Hampden House is to return children who have Social, Emotional and Behavioural needs, after appropriate support, to mainstream schools and their home communities. All placements are short term and in line with County Inclusion Policies.

This is brought about by:

1. An accelerated, targeted individualised learning programme
2. An individualised targeted behavioural management programme
3. Access to the "whole" school curriculum
4. Close liaison and positive support work with the family
5. Close liaison with and support work with other agencies*.

The category of child that will be provided for will be those designated as having Social, Emotional and Behavioural Needs whose family and/or personal circumstances impact adversely upon educational opportunities. Some degree of additional special educational need will be considered under advisement.
